Factbook Glossary

Description of Dataset: The dataset used for Fact Book enrollment reporting matched the "home institution" students reported in the SUNY SIRIS system. Hence, the dataset is the total number of students enrolled in credit-bearing courses as of the Fall 2023 term census date. Senior Learners who are auditing credit courses, students enrolled in FIT degree programs at SUNY Korea, graduate students in maintenance of matriculation, and visiting students in International Exchange major code 7777 are omitted.

Age

Age is calculated as of the first day of the term, using the full date for both student birth date and the first day of the term.

Citizenship Status

Whether a student is an international student or not. An international student is defined as not a U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Undocumented student.

EOP Status

Whether a student is or was formerly active in the State University of New York's Arthur O. Eve Educational Opportunity Program. EOP offers financial and support services to eligible New York State residents who qualify as economically disadvantaged.

Excelsior Status

Whether a student received an Excelsior scholarship. The New York State Excelsior Scholarship covers any remaining gap in tuition expenses after other federal and state grants and scholarships are applied up to a limit for eligible New York State residents attending public colleges and universities in the state.

Gender

Whether a student is Male or Female according to the Legal Sex field in Banner. The Legal sex field has a new value, X Another Legal Sex, as it is a new option on the SUNY application and will be available for reporting in future Fact Books.

Housing Status

Whether the student is an On-Campus Resident (living in one of FIT's four residence halls) or is an Off-Campus/Commuter student (not living in a FIT residence hall).

Pell Status

Whether a student was awarded a Federal Pell Grant. Pell grants are awarded to U.S. citizens who are undergraduate students who meet financial need requirements and are enrolled or accepted into eligible degree programs.

Legal Nation

A student's legal nation registered on their active student visa to study in the United States for the term.

Military Status

Whether the student is on active duty (currently serving in the US Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or the Coast Guard), is a dependent or spouse of active-duty personnel, or a veteran (served but is not on active duty).

Race/Ethnicity Reporting

Race/Ethnicity categories are based on reporting rules adopted by the federal Bureau of Budget and Management in 1997, which are currently used by the National Center for Education Statistics in IPEDS reporting and SUNY reporting. Information on citizenship status, Hispanic origin, and race is collected from students. Students who are not citizens or U.S. nationals are reported as nonresident aliens, regardless of how they respond to the Hispanic origin and race questions. Of the remaining students, those who indicate that they are of Hispanic origin are reported as Hispanic, regardless of how they answer the race question.

SUNY definitions

Hispanic

A person of Central American, Cuban, Dominican, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

American Indian or Alaska Native

A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community attachment.

Asian

A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian Subcontinent, including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.

Black or African-American

A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.

Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander

A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

White

A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.

Nonresident alien

A person who is not a citizen or national of the United States is in this country on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely. For the purposes of this report, we use the nonresident alien status to identify international students.

Multi-racial

A person who indicates belonging to more than one race category.

Not Reported

The category used to report students whose race and ethnicity are unknown.

Permanent Residence Address

A student's permanent address indicates their primary residence, which may differ from the local address where they reside while attending school. For dependent students, the permanent address is often their parents' or guardian's address. The student's residency status for tuition purposes may be different from their permanent residence.

TAP Status

Whether a student was awarded a grant through the New York State Tuition Assistance Program (TAP). TAP offers a grant to legal residents of New York State attending approved schools who maintain at least a C average as of the 4th semester and meet income eligibility requirements.
