





2. What CET services do you normally use?




3. How often do you use the CET (B 502)?




4. If you use the CET, website and/or calendar, how often do you use these resources?




5. If you are an adjunct professor, have you ever visited the CET's adjunct portal?




6.If you are an adjunct professor, have you attended an Adjunct Summer Institute?




7. Do you attend technology training sessions such as Blackboard, Voicethread or The Teaching with Technology Certificate Program?



Thank you very much for having this CET room available 24/7. Most of the time the workshops are not compatible with my adjunct schedule.

I suggest sending out "quick fix" suggestions for teaching and Blackboard, like how to move the quickly attendance forward in the menu, so it is easier to find in a hurry, or how to do an easy discussion on line to make up for a snow day. I mean, I end up figuring things out on my own for the most part, but a very short message that solves a small problem is probably going to have more impact than something asking for a large time commitment. With the adjunct folks, anyway. ALSO, we all hear about collaboration, small groups, pair and share, flipped classroom, which sounds good, but many teachers don't know how to make it work. Small groups can quickly devolve into gossip sessions if they aren't monitored/prompted well, so professors then say, ugh, it doesn't work. It does work, but only in short bursts. How about sending, maybe monthly, a "quick activity" idea that people could use in their teaching? Not an ice breaker, but something that can carry real content. I can always use reminders and tips and tricks. Grab and go pedagogy sounds sloppy, but it doesn't have to be. Maybe call it Pret a Pedgogy? The key is to make the post/message/email very short. A "try this."
