Frequently Asked Questions About Registration for Senior Scholars at FIT

What are the dates of Spring Semester classes?

Monday, January 30 through Monday, May 21, 2012.

What does it cost to register and audio a course?

The cost is \$35.00 for a Senior Scholar to audit a course offered by the School of Liberal Arts, Art & Design, or Business & Technology. The cost is \$50.00 for a computer training course for seniors.

Payment is by credit card, check, or money order; no cash. The registration fee is not refundable, and no changes may be made after initial course selection.

What courses are available to Senior Scholars at FIT?

The list of courses will be available at registration on January 27. The list will be regularly updated online at www.fitnyc.edu/6837.asp

Are there prerequisites for taking a course?

Some courses have prerequisites and require completion of a specific course or courses prior to enrolling. In some cases, the permission of the department chairperson is required.

Will I receive a grade or academic credit?

No. Senior Scholars are auditors and are not held to the normal academic requirements of the course. You do not receive grades or credits.

Where do I come for Registration on January 27, 2012?

The FIT Conference Center. Enter from the south side of 28th Street, a short distance west of Seventh Avenue. Registration will take place in the Great Hall.

What if I arrive after the lottery closes at 2:00 pm on January 27?

You will be given the opportunity to register for a course after all lottery ticket holders have been served.
