Student Ambassador Qualifications:



- Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Demonstrate a desire to learn about FIT: its regulations, people, programs, and community
- Must report on time for assignments
- Must be willing to help, have good communication skills, and have the ability to work patiently with a large volume of people.
- International students are welcome to apply but must have a social security number before they begin working.

Job Description:

1. Ambassadors have the opportunity to select work assignments which fit their schedule; however, they must be available for most of the following dates during the 2012 - 2013 academic year (dates may vary slightly).



- Resident Move-In: Aug. 18-19
- New Student Success Week/Orientation: Aug. 20 - 26
- Week of Welcome: Aug. 27 – Aug. 31
- Parents Day: November 10th
- Events scheduled at common hour during the first month of classes
- Evening events scheduled during the first months of classes
- There will be other assignments for ambassadors to assist with through out the year.

2. Ambassadors must attend training programs before some assignments. There will be two general training sessions for all ambassadors.

3. Ambassadors will meet approximately once a month during each semester for updates, training, and to sign up for additional assignments.

4. Ambassadors must make a commitment to the program through May 2013

5. Ambassadors will participate in an evaluation and assessment process.

- There will be many opportunities to develop public speaking skills, leadership skills, and human relations skills.
- Salary will be \$7.25 per hour (subject to change)
- Student Ambassadors t-shirt and/or jacket are provided.
