## Introduction

Since the FIT rebrand in 2018, the institution has successfully delivered visual communications through consistent applications across all available platforms using the guidelines set forth in the new brand guidelines.

With the brand now well established, the palette has been expanded beyond the initial three brand colors, offering additional creative options for the college's print and digital materials.

The supplemental colors are designed to support and complement FIT's current branding; they should be applied clearly and consistently to ensure that the institutional branding is maintained.

Application of the new color options requires continued adherance to the existing brand guidelines set forth in 2018.

## 1.0 <br> Color

Within the FIT brand, there are three color palettes : the Official School Palette, the Spectrum Palette and the Adaptive Palette. Each have specific usage context; for further information, please refer to Section 6 in the FIT Brand Guidelines.

## Color on Logos

All FIT logos should only be rendered in Black, White, Official School Color Palette or Supplementary Color Palette avoiding the contrast scenarios shown below. FIT lockups must be large enough to pass the accessibility test.

## Using the Supplementary Color Palette

Do - use Supplementary Color Palette for FIT lockups on white backgrounds.


Do - use Supplementary Color Palette on FIT logos with black text

Do - use white lockups on backgrounds using Supplementary Color Palette


Do - use black lockups on backgrounds using Supplementary Color Palette


Do - use colored lockups on backgrounds using Official and Supplementary Color Palettes that provide enough complementary contrast


Don't - use different colors (either Official or Supplementary) in FIT lockup


Don't - use different lockup colors in combination with one another (either Official or Supplementary) that do not provide enough or complementary contrast

## Color Do's

Colors should be used with white or shades of the same color. Overall, designs should feel bright and vibrant with majority of white or Supplementary color

## Using the Supplementary Color Palette

Do - use white graphics on Supplementary Color background


Do - use Supplementary Color and Official Color Palette in graphics and backgrounds together that are bright and complimentary


Do - use shades of a Supplementary Color for backgrounnds

## Color Don'ts

All FIT logos should only be rendered in Black, White, Official School Color Palette or Supplementary Color Palette avoiding the contrast scenarios shown below.

## Using the Supplementary Color Palette

Don't - use color graphics using the Supplementary Color Palette that do not provide enough contrast between different colors


Don't - use color graphics using more than one Official Color Palette with Supplementary Colors


Don't - use Official and Supplementary Colors in graphic elements and backgrounds together that are not complementary


Don't - use graphic elements using the Supplementary Color Palette that do not provide enough contrast between different colors


Don't - use Supplementary Colors with text on other colors that is difficult to read or does not provide enough contrast


Don't - use too many color combinations of from the Official Color Palette and Supplementary Color Palette
