

How to Add **LinkedIn Learning** to Blackboard Courses


LinkedIn Learning is Replacing Lynda.com

Key Points

1. **LinkedIn Learning** replaces Lynda.com. (Effective fall 2019)
2. **Links to Lynda.com tutorials will cease to work at the end of the year. (December 31, 2019)**
Please update your all of your courses before spring 2020 to use [LinkedIn Learning](#).
3. **LinkedIn Learning** is located in the **Blackboard Content Marketplace**.
4. **Start by updating your account in MyFIT under web resources.** Sign into MyFIT <https://myfit.fitnyc.edu/>
5. You have the **option** to connect your FIT account to your personal LinkedIn account. If connected you will be able to access FIT LinkedIn Learning through your LinkedIn account. Badges of completion will appear in your profile.

1 Select Web Resources, 2 Click on LinkedIn Learning (LL)

Once you have signed in you can access LL directly or through Blackboard. Your students need to do this as well.






