Factbook Glossary

Description of Dataset: This data set used reports on the total number of degrees awarded between the 2018–2019 and 2022–2023 academic school years (July 1st to June 30th) and reported to the SUNY SIRIS system within one reporting period after conferral.

Award

The specific degree, diploma, or certificate granted by an institution upon completion of the requirements of a program.

Associate Degree

An award that normally requires at least 2 but less than 4 years of full-time equivalent college work. (e.g., A.A.S.)

Bachelor's Degree

An award that normally requires at least four but no more than 5 years of full-time equivalent college-level work. (e.g., B.S. and B.F.A.)

Master's Degree

An award that requires the successful completion of a program of study of at least the full-time equivalent of 1 but not more than 2 academic years of work beyond the bachelor's degree. (e.g., M.A., M.F.A., and M.P.S.)

Undergraduate Credit Certificate

A recognized postsecondary credential program offered by an institution is generally a shorter program that concentrates on a specific field or expertise. Approved by SUNY, FIT's credit certificates range from 4 to 6 courses each, and total undergraduate credits range from 8.5 to 15.

Completer

A student who receives a degree, certificate, or other recognized postsecondary credential. In order to be considered a completer, the degree/award must actually be conferred.

Minor

A selection of courses focused on a particular discipline or a combination of disciplines. Normally consisting of 5 courses or ~15 credits. Completion of a minor is recognized on a graduate's transcript.

Primary Award Level

The award level of the academic program, either Certificate, Associate, Baccalaureate, or Master's.

Program

A course of study leading to a formal award given by the institution, such as a degree, diploma, or certificate.

School

The school that houses the degree, minor, or certificate program, e.g., the School of Art and Design, the Jay and Patty Baker School of Business and Technology, the School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, or the School of Graduate Studies.
