

Glossary

Description of Dataset: The dataset used reports on the total number of awards conferred between the 2020–2021 and 2024–2025 academic school years (July 1st to June 30th) and reported to the SUNY SIRIS system within one reporting period after conferral. Awards conferred by FIT at SUNY Korea awards are reported separately at the end of the factbook.

Fact Book Source: Official SIRIS Degrees Conferred Dataset and BANNER Degree Tables (for Minors conferred)

Award

The specific degree, diploma, or certificate an institution grants upon completing a program's requirements.

Associate Degree

An award that normally requires at least two but less than four years of full-time equivalent college work. (e.g., A.A.S.)

Bachelor's Degree

An award that normally requires at least four but no more than five years of full-time equivalent college-level work. (e.g., B.S. and B.F.A.)

Master's Degree

An award that requires the successful completion of a program of study of at least the full-time equivalent of 1 but not more than two academic years of work beyond the bachelor's degree. (M.A., M.F.A., and M.P.S.)

Undergraduate Credit Certificate

A recognized postsecondary credential program offered by an institution is generally a shorter program concentrating on a specific field or expertise. Approved by SUNY, FIT's credit certificates range from 4 to 6 courses each, and total undergraduate credits range from 8.5 to 15.

Completer

A student who receives a degree, certificate, or other recognized postsecondary credential. To be considered a completer, the degree/award must be conferred.

Minor

A selection of courses focused on a particular discipline or a combination of disciplines. Normally consisting of 5 courses or ~15 credits. Completion of a minor is recognized on a graduate's transcript.

Program

A course of study leading to a formal award given by the institution, such as a degree, diploma, or certificate.

Program Award Level

The award level of the degree program, either Nondegree, Associate (AAS Associate in Applied Science), Bachelor's (Bachelor in Fine Arts, Bachelor of Science), or Master's (Master of Arts, Master of Fine Arts, Master of Professional Studies).

School

Within FIT, one of four schools that grants degrees: The School of Art and Design, the Jay and Patty Baker School of Business and Technology, the School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and the School of Graduate Studies. A Dean leads each School.

Housed School: One of four schools in which a student's degree program is housed.
