





AAFTE Ten Year Trend by Term









AAFTE and Fall Headcount Ten Year Trend by Student Enrollment Status









AAFTE and Fall Headcount Ten Year Trend by Student Degree Level









AAFTE and Fall Headcount Ten Year Trend by Student Degree-Seeking Status









AAFTE and Fall Headcount Ten Year Trend by Student Award Level






AAFTE and Fall Headcount Five Year Trend by Student Tuition Rate







Factbook Glossary:

Description of Dataset:

This fact book draws from two main data sources. The first is AAFTE (Annual Average Full-Time Equivalent), which uses official end-of-term course registration data for state-fundable, credit-bearing courses, but excludes Special Auditors' registrations (which are never state-fundable). The second is Fall Headcount, which comes from official SUNY census enrollment data for credit-bearing courses. Both datasets report "home institution students" and thus exclude several groups: Special Auditors, FIT students at SUNY Korea, graduate students in maintenance of matriculation, and International Exchange students (major code 7777).

Annual Average Full-Time Enrollment (AAFTE)

One AAFTE workload is equivalent to 30 student credit hours for undergraduate and graduate courses. This SUNY unit of measure applies to an academic year and is derived from attempted credit hours in the term section course data campus submission. This is the standard calculation used by SUNY System Administration to determine state–supported AAFTE funding amounts. AAFTE calculations detail student registrations in only credit–bearing, state–fundable courses.

Degree Level

The level of a student's award program, either undergraduate (Certificate, Associate, or Bachelor's) or graduate (Master's).

Degree Status

Whether a student is a degree-seeking student (has been accepted by and enrolled in one of the college's Certificate, Associate, Bachelor, or Graduate degree programs) or a nondegree student (enrolled in credit-bearing courses but has not been accepted by and enrolled in a degree program and could be working towards completion of a certificate).

Enrollment Status

Whether a student is full-time (an undergraduate taking 12 or more credits in a term or a graduate student taking nine or more credits in a term) or part-time (an undergraduate taking fewer than 12 credits in a term or a graduate student taking fewer than nine credits in a term).

Headcount Enrollment

The count of students enrolled at FIT as of the census date. For full-length courses in the fall or spring semesters, the Census date is the 21st day of classes.

Primary Award Level

The award level of a student's academic program, either Certificate, Associate, Baccalaureate, or Master's.

Home School

Within FIT, one of four schools in which a student's academic degree program is housed: The School of Art and Design, the Jay and Patty Baker School of Business and Technology, the School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and the School of Graduate Studies. A Dean leads each School. A student not matriculated into an academic program is not in a school and is reported as Nondegree.

Subject School

Within FIT, one of four schools offering course sections: The School of Art and Design, the Jay and Patty Baker School of Business and Technology, the School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and the School of Graduate Studies. A Dean leads each School. Some internship (IC) and interdisciplinary courses do not fall under a specific school and are counted as 'Other.'

Tuition Rate

The tuition rate the student paid during the term, in-state or out-of-state. Students residing in New York City are reported separately from the rest of New York State resident students, but both groups pay the same in-state rate.

*Additional Note: The program that creates these tables conducts calculations before rounding decimals, so percentages may appear not to total 100%.
