Retention Methodology:

Retention rates measure the percentage of a cohort of students who return to the same institution in a future term. Typically, retention rates are calculated from fall-to-fall and are referred to as one-year retention rates. The U.S. Department of Education (DoEd) collects one-year retention rates for first-time, full-time degree-seeking students who enter in the fall for the first time and return the following fall.

Graduation rates measure the percentage of a cohort of students who complete their program at the same institution within a specified period. The institution defines that period as the expected time it would take to complete and is referred to as the *normal time to completion* by the U.S. DoEd. At FIT, that period is defined as two years for most associate and all bachelor's programs, with a few one-year programs at the associate level. Hence, for a typical two-year program, graduating within two years is referred to as completing within 100% of normal time, graduating within three years is 150% of normal time, and within four years is 200% of normal time.

The federal government passed several legislative acts to collect graduation rates for specific groups and make the rates available to the public. The primary cohort reported widely is the full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who started and finished at the same institution within 150% of the normal time.

Students are included in this report if they satisfy the following criteria:

- 1) Entered FIT during the Fall term between 2017 and 2023
- 2) Entered FIT as a degree-seeking student
- 3) Entered FIT as a full-time student

This analysis follows these fall student cohorts from when they first enrolled at FIT through the Fall of 2023 and differs from IPEDS as it includes outcomes for students that transfer into FIT from other institutions.

Part-time and nondegree students are omitted. Note that the Academic Program Profile reports prepared for departments by Institutional Research utilize a different methodology to determine the entering cohort. In those reports, the entering cohort for a program includes students who began as part-time students and internal transfers within the same degree level.

Refer to the Glossary at the end of this document for explanations of the terms used throughout this report.

Glossary:

Description of Dataset: Students were included in the dataset if they satisfied the following criteria: entered FIT during the Fall term between 2017 and 2023, entered FIT as a degree-seeking student, and entered FIT as a full-time student. Hence, part-time and nondegree students were omitted.

Factbook Source: Official SIRIS Census Enrollment Dataset and Official SIRIS Degree Award Dataset sourced from BANNER, as well as National Student Clearinghouse enrollment records.

Attrition

Student attrition is the number of individuals who left a FIT program before completing it who did not graduate or continue to be enrolled at FIT or another institution. An attrition rate is the percentage of students from an entering cohort who did not earn a degree/certificate, are not persisting towards a degree/certificate, and did not transfer to another institution by a specific reporting date.

Cohort Term

The term in which a cohort of students begins their study at FIT. This report considers only students who start in a Fall term.

Degree-seeking student

A student who has been accepted by and enrolled in one of the college's Certificate, Associate, Bachelor, or Graduate degree programs.

Enrollment Status

Whether a student is full-time (an undergraduate taking 12 or more credits in a term or a graduate student taking nine or more credits in a term) or part-time (an undergraduate taking fewer than 12 credits in a term or a graduate student taking fewer than nine credits in a term).

Entering Cohort

A cohort is a group of students established for tracking purposes. For this report, the entering cohort is the group of full-time degree-seekers who enroll in a Fall term as first-time, transfer, transition, or new graduate students.

Gender

Whether a student/employee is Male, Female, or another recognized category according to the Legal Sex field in Banner, which is comprised of either M, F, or X. The category X is inclusive of, but not limited to, gender-sex categories such as non-binary, intersex, genderfluid, and genderqueer.

Higher Education History

A student's higher education history as of the enrollment term:

First-time Undergraduate

An undergraduate student who has not attended any post-secondary institution after completing/terminating their high school education and has enrolled at FIT for the first time during the term. 'First-time' includes students who earned some college credits during high school (AP credits, etc.).

Transfer Undergraduate

An undergraduate student who attended another post-secondary institution prior to enrolling in an Associate or Baccalaureate degree program at FIT.

Transition Undergrad

A student who completed or is expected to complete an associate degree at FIT during the next semester is now entering a Baccalaureate program at FIT for the first semester.

Continuing Undergraduate

An undergraduate student in the current term who has previously enrolled at FIT.

New Graduate

A student who is enrolled in a FIT graduate program for the first time.

Returning/Continuing Graduate

A student who has previously attended FIT as a graduate student.

Not Retained

A student who is not enrolled at the institution. For retention, this is evaluated in the Fall following the student's first academic year. For Three-Year Graduation, this is evaluated for the Fall following the student's third academic year.

Pell Status

Whether a student was awarded a Federal Pell Grant. Pell grants are awarded to U.S. citizens who are undergraduate students who meet financial need requirements and are enrolled or accepted into eligible degree programs.

Program Award Level

The award level of the degree program, either Nondegree, Associate (AAS Associate in Applied Science), Bachelor's (Bachelor in Fine Arts, Bachelor of Science), or Master's (Master of Arts, Master of Fine Arts, Master of Professional Studies).

Race/Ethnicity Reporting

Race/Ethnicity categories are based on reporting rules adopted by the federal Bureau of Budget and Management in 1997, which are currently used by the National Center for Education Statistics in IPEDS reporting and SUNY reporting. Information on national origin, Hispanic origin, and race is collected from students. Students who are not citizens or U.S. nationals are reported as international, regardless of how they respond to the Hispanic origin and race questions. Of the remaining students, those who indicate that they are of Hispanic origin are reported as Hispanic, regardless of how they answer the race question.

Hispanic

An individual having Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish origins.

American Indian or Alaska Native

A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

Asian

A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian Subcontinent, including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.

Black or African-American

A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.

Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander

A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

White

An individual having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe.

International (Non-US Citizen Visa Holder)

A person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely. Note: "International student" aligns with the IPEDS definition for "U.S. Nonresident" and is therefore reported separately rather than in any of the racial/ethnic categories.

Middle Eastern

An individual having origins of Middle East or North Africa.

Multi-racial

A person who indicates belonging to more than one race category.

Not Reported

The category used to report students whose race and ethnicity are unknown.

Retained or Graduated in Program

A student who is still enrolled in, or has graduated from, the program they began during the cohort term. For a student to count as graduated in the three-year status and time-to-degree reports, their degree award must have been posted in BANNER before the Fall term following the three-year tracking period. For a student to count as graduated in retention reports, their degree award must have been posted in BANNER and submitted to SUNY on time or one report period late.

Retained at FIT in another Program

A student who is retained at FIT but not in the same program they initially entered as a first-time, transfer, transition, or new Graduate student.

School

Within FIT, one of four schools that grants degrees: The School of Art and Design, the Jay and Patty Baker School of Business and Technology, the School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and the School of Graduate Studies. A Dean leads each School.

Three-Year Graduation Rate and Outcomes

Graduating within three years is 150% of the normal time and is the standard graduation rate measurement for benchmarking outcomes for two-year programs. Graduation, transfer, and FIT persistence are mutually exclusive outcomes. The Graduation outcome is determined first. Enrollment at another institution is determined if the student has enrollment record(s) at another institution within the tracking period.

- · Graduated: Students who earned a degree at FIT within the tracking period.
- Persist at FIT: Students enrolled at FIT in the fall term following the three-year tracking period.
- Transfer Out: Students who have enrollment records at another institution within the three-year period
- · Attrition: Students who do not complete, remain enrolled, or transfer out.

Time to Completion

The time between the start date of the cohort term and a student's graduation date. For this report, an August graduate is considered to have taken the same amount of time as a graduate from the preceding May. December and January graduates are considered to have taken the same amount of time as a graduate the following May. The expected time it would take to complete a program is referred to as the "normal time to completion" by the U.S. Department of Education. At FIT, normal time is defined as two years for most associate and all bachelor's programs, with a few one-year programs at the associate level. Hence, for a typical two-year program, graduating within two years is referred to as completing within 100% of normal time, graduating within three years is 150% of normal time, and within four years is 200% of normal time.

The time-to-completion tables in this report were calculated for five years with students having one of the following outcomes:

- Two Years or Less (100%)
- · Three Years (150%)
- · Four Years (200%)
- · Five Years or More
- Did not Complete
