- The Corporation is required to adopt its annual budget for Fiscal Year
 2008 and to approve all related fees.
- 2. A proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2008 is attached.
- 3. Based on projected operating expenditures and an ongoing need for capital expenditures, an increase of 15% is now warranted, as follows:

- 4. The fee for the mandatory meal plan for dorm-room students will range from \$2,790 to \$3,590 in FY08.
- 5. The technology fee for data, telecommunications and cable service was \$225 per year in the 2006-2007 academic year, and whereas a study of technology costs has shown that this amount does not cover services that are provided, an increase of \$50 to \$275 per year is proposed to continue to align actual costs with revenues generated by this fee.
- 6. The student resident association fee of \$50 per year is not proposed to increase in the upcoming academic year.
